

Available Resources to Provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for the Consumer Directed Services (CDS) Option

The purpose of this notification is to alert CDS members and providers of the availability of PPE. Read below to learn how to request personal protective equipment (PPE) supplies for CDS members.

What is new

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) has identified a process for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) to request personal protective equipment (PPE) (i.e. surgical masks, gloves, hand sanitizer and sanitary wipes) on behalf of their members who use the CDS option. This process uses the Texas Division of Emergency Management's (TDEM) State of Texas Assistance Requests (STARs) system.

Key details

BCBSTX may submit a request for PPE using the process outline below. There is no cost to BCBSTX to receive the PPE through this process. However, BCBSTX is responsible for the cost of delivery of the PPE to their members after TDEM delivers the PPE items.

Request process

- Members will reach out to their Financial Management Services Agency (FMSA) to request PPE supplies.
- FMSAs will submit their PPE supply requests to BCBSTX at <u>TexasMedicaidNetworkDepartment@bcbstx.com</u> using the following PPE Type and Quantity Requested Report, and provide an address to send the PPE.
- BCBSTX will follow the process for submitting the request to the HHSC CDS policy team for processing.

PPE Type and Quantity Requested Report Reminder: PPE orders are not guaranteed. TDEM fills requests based on what is available in stock at the time the order is placed. Availability of PPE items may fluctuate depending on current level of demand for the items at a given time.
