



COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Codes 0071A and 0072A now Benefits for Medicaid & CHIP

What is new

For dates of service on or after October 29, 2021, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) of the vaccine administration procedure codes 0071A and 0072A for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine as benefits of Medicaid and CHIP for ages five through 11 years of age. Vaccine **procedure code 91307** is informational only, while the vaccine is distributed to the provider free of charge.

Reimbursement

We won't reimburse for Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines that providers received for free. Providers should not charge members for the vaccine. **We will reimburse for the administration of the vaccine.** Other medically necessary treatment for COVID-19 will be covered consistent with the terms of the member's benefit plan.
