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COVID-19: Provider Enrollment Revalidation Due Dates Extended – Texas Medicaid

Due dates extended

As directed by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC). Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) Medicaid will extend provider revalidation due dates through **June 30, 2021** to prevent provider disenrollment/disruption. Providers can view the revalidation status on the Provider Information Management System (PIMS).

The following revalidation due dates have been extended:

Original due date | Extended due date March 2020 | June 30, 2021

What actions are required by providers?

Per HHSC, providers should submit revalidation applications before the deadline to avoid disensollment. As a reminder, providers can submit their revalidation application up to 90 days before the due date.

Note: Texas Medicaid and CSHCN Services Program providers should confirm their current enrollment information in the Provider Information Management System (PIMS) prior to submitting their revalidation application.
