Abbreviation	Measure
WCC	Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity
CIS	Childhood Immunization Status
IMA	Immunizations for Adolescents
CBP	Controlling High Blood Pressure
CDC	Comprehensive Diabetes Care
PPC	Prenatal and Postpartum Care

In early February 2021, we will contact your office to verify the contact information in order to provide you with your medical record requests. We will make a follow-up call to verify the list was received and discuss the retrieval of records.

Date	Activity
Early February 2021	Medical record pull lists are faxed to provider offices
April 16, 2021	Deadline for providers to submit medical records
April 22, 2021	Deadline for BCBSTX record abstraction
