

Reporting Critical Incidents

Reminder

BCBSTX Medicaid Providers are responsible for reporting critical incidents to the health plan and applicable state agency (Department of Family Protective Services (DFPS)) within 24 hours of identification. In addition, you should report all deaths to BCBSTX Healthcare Management team at 1-877-301-4394 (STAR Kids) or 1-888-657-6061 (STAR/CHIP) for reporting to Texas Health and Human Services (HHSC).

What is a Critical Incident?

A **critical incident** is an event that may harm, or create the potential for harm to, an individual. Critical incidents include but are not limited to the following:

- Abuse, Neglect, or Exploitation (ANE);
- The unauthorized use of restraint, seclusion, or restrictive interventions;
- Serious injuries that require medical intervention or result in hospitalization;
- Criminal victimization;
- Unexplained death;
- Medication errors; and other incidents or events that involve harm or risk of harm to a Member
