

# Updated 7/30/2020 | Posted 04/15/2020 COVID-19: Texas Health Steps Medical and Dental Checkups

## What is new?

Effective June 26, 2020, per the <u>Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC)</u> is extending the end date to October 23, 2020, during this rapidly evolving COVID-19 situation, Texas Health Steps encourages you to continue to adjust your clinical operations based on your professional medical judgement and/or guidance from professional medical and dental societies.

# These adjustments may include:

- Temporary postponement of certain check-ups
- Limit check-ups to certain times of the day
- Dedicate specific rooms for sick visits and well visits
- Focus on visits for younger children, especially those due for routine vaccines

# What Actions Should Providers Take:

Providers may choose to continue to provide in-person medical exams for children entering Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) conservatorship ("3-day exam"). This is an opportunity for the provider to see a child new to DFPS conservatorship and for the new caregiver to have information about the child's health as these medical visits are very important.
