

Webinars: Register Now for Texas Medicaid Autism Services Policy

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) is sharing information from Health and Human Services (HHSC)

What is New

HHSC will provide BCBSTX with information on aspects of the <u>Autism Services benefit</u> such as systems updates and Licensed Behavior Analyst (LBA) enrollment updates to help prepare for implementation of this benefit.

Effective for dates of services on or after February 1, 2022, Autism Services, to include Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) evaluation and treatment, will be a benefit of the Texas Health Steps-Comprehensive Care Program (THSteps-CCP). The requirements are as follows:

- Texas Medicaid recipients are 20 years of age and younger
- Meet the criteria outlined in the Autism Service benefit
- BCBSTX reimbursement is on a non-risk basis for provision of the services
- Providers are expected to follow all aspects of the medical policy, including prior authorization criteria

- Guidelines and components of the comprehensive diagnostic evaluation needed prior to
- requesting services
- Treatment planning, caregiver involvement, and other requirements for providing ABA
- treatment services as a Texas Medicaid benefit.

November 4, 2021 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. to register. The second webinar will cover:

- Frequency and duration guidelines for ABA services
- Procedures for initiation of ABA treatment and 90-day extensions
- Documentation requirements for prior authorization of the initiation of ABA treatment, 90-
- day extension, and recertification
- Criteria for re-evaluation, discharge, or discontinuation

The first two webinars will include a live presentation and question-and-answer (Q&A) session. Participants will be able to submit questions throughout the webinars.
